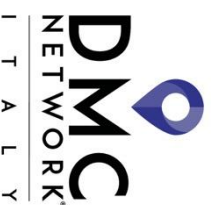


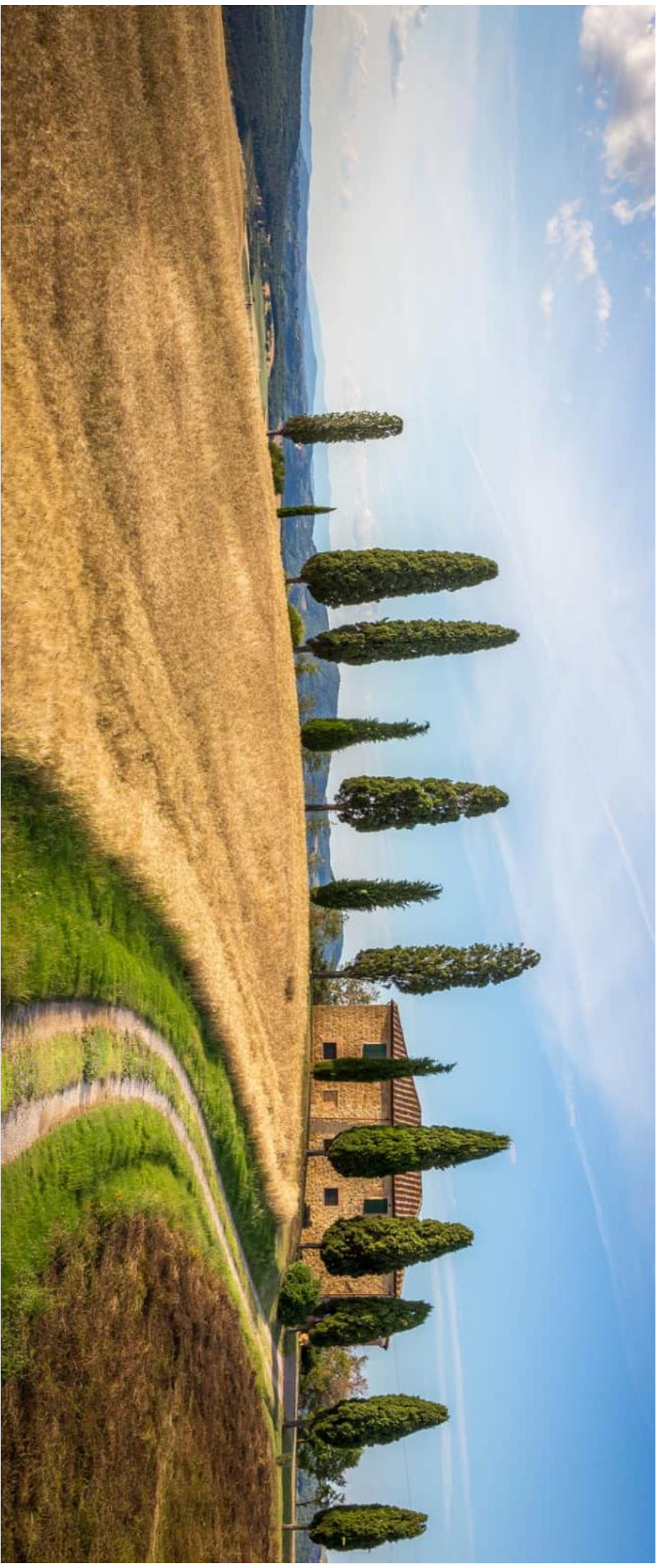

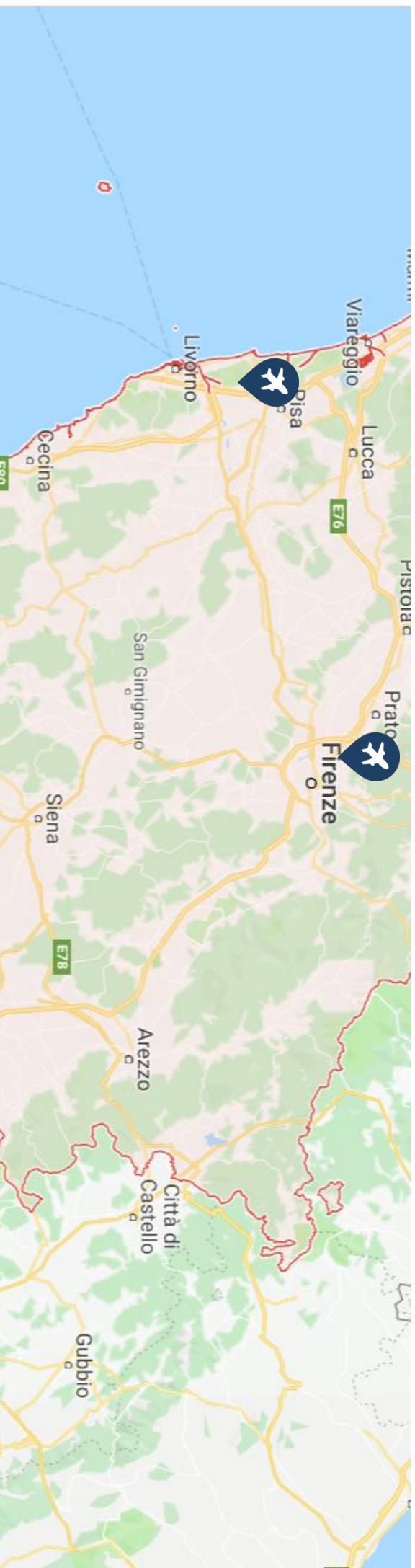

Tuscan Countryside map

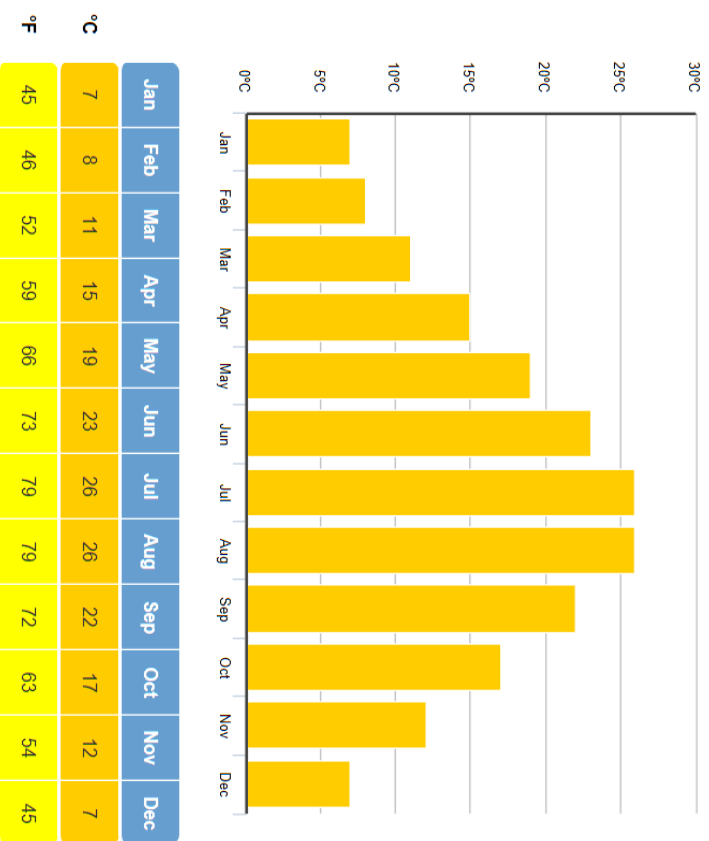
Amerigo Vespucci Airport

Galileo Galilei Airport

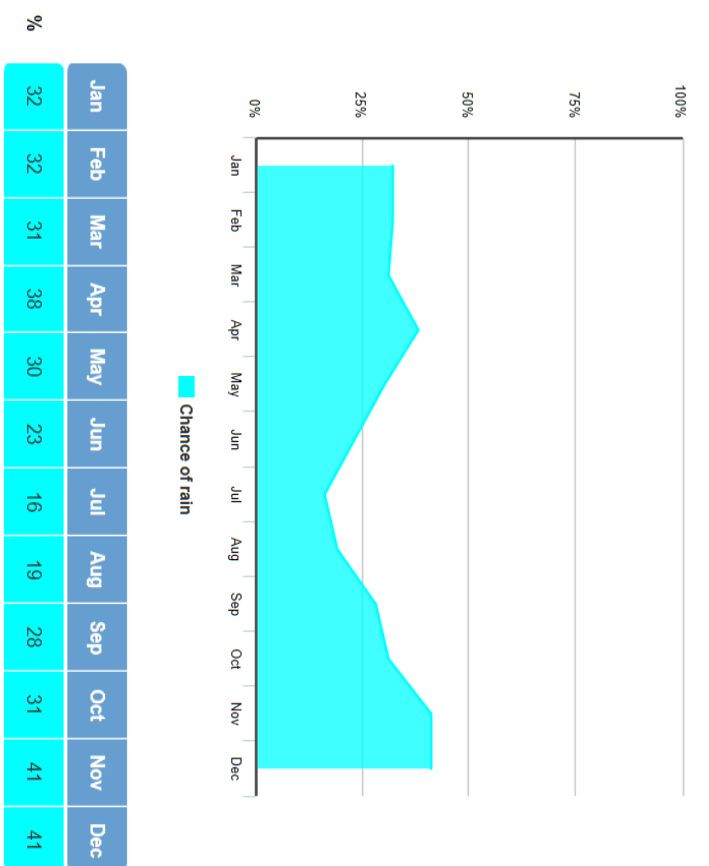


Countryside Climate

Day 1

Vintage Cars Tour

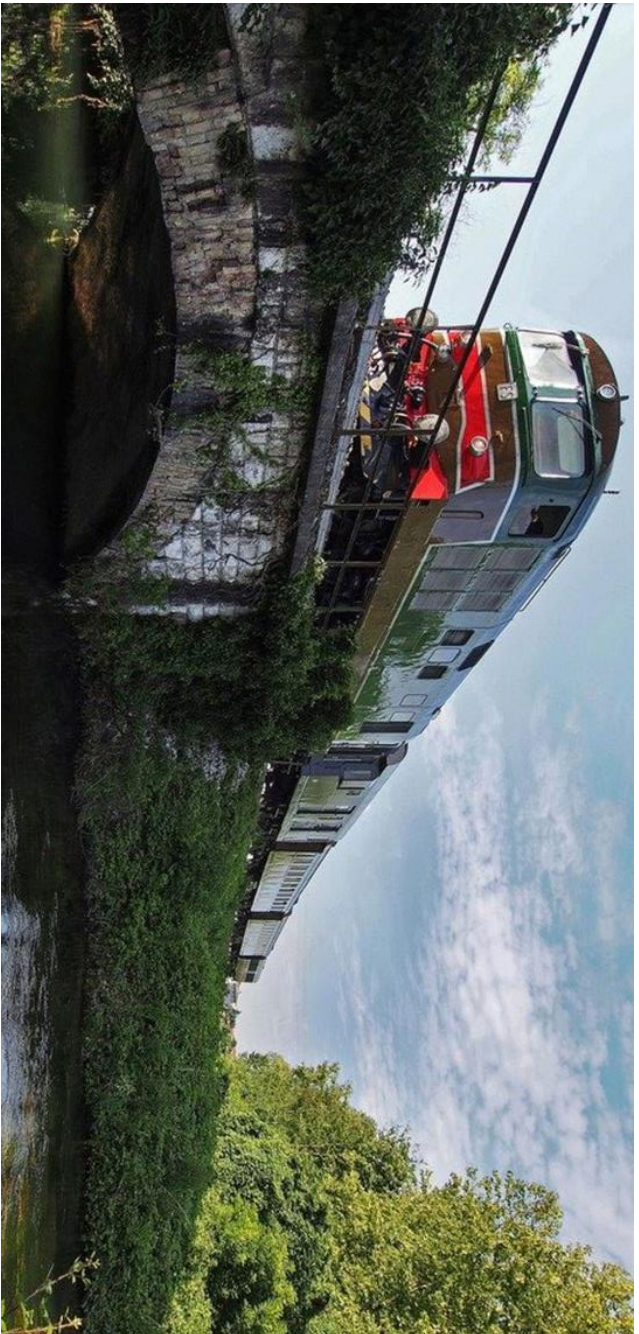
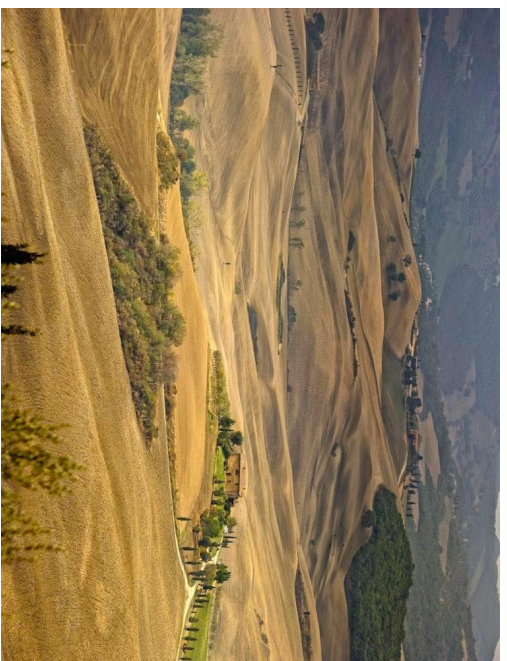
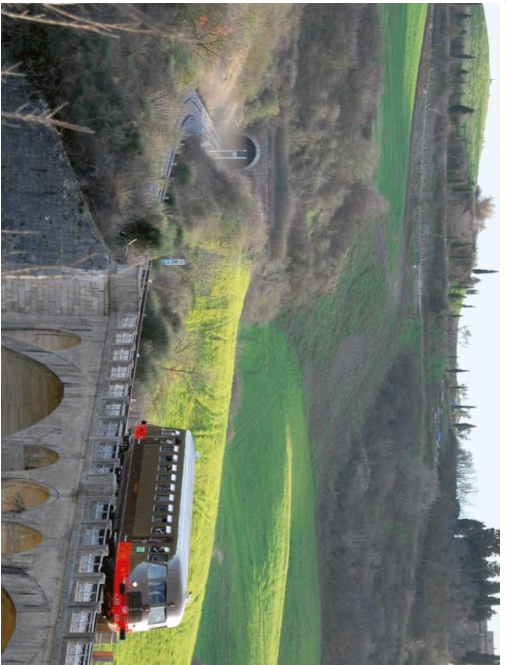
Stop For Tycal Local Product Tasting And Lunch On The Way To The Hotel

This is a place where the landscape of the Tuscan hills, made of vineyards and olive trees, melds with a thousand-year history of one of the most important Italian families.

In this Tuscan land between Florence and Siena, the family of the estate follows organic agricultural methods to produce Chianti Classico and high quality extra virgin olive oil.

The estate in the Chianti countryside near Florence consists of a rectangular villa. Inside, a spacious courtyard with an arched loggia opens to the rooms of the villa on the ground floor: Sala delle Donne, Sala dei Titoli, Sala Clemente XII, and Salone a Tramontana.





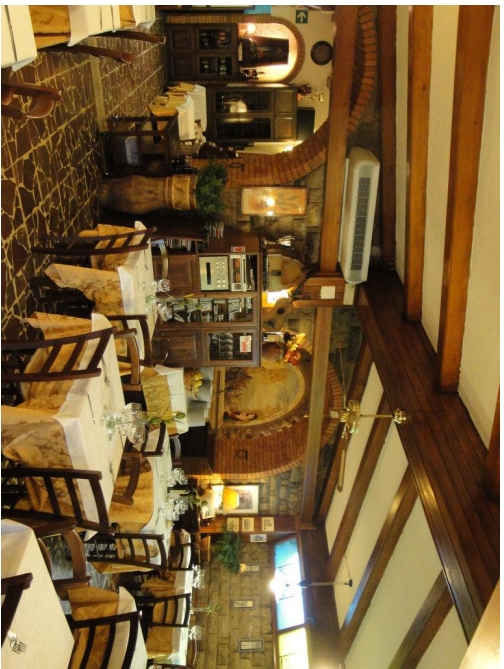
Day 2

Steam Train Private Tour

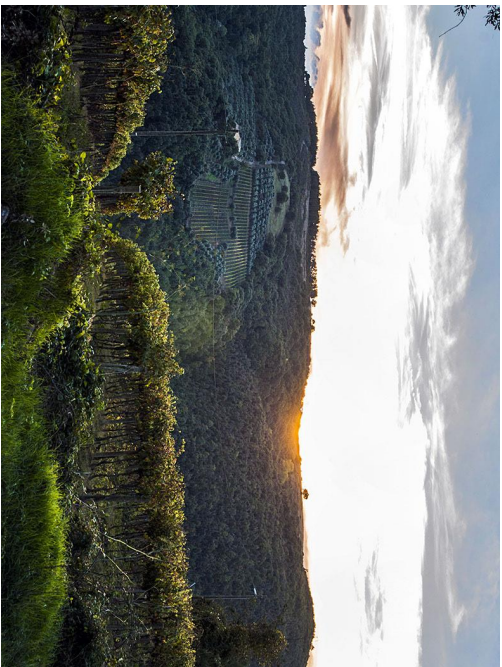
Opt. 1) Lunch In A Typical Countryside Restaurant

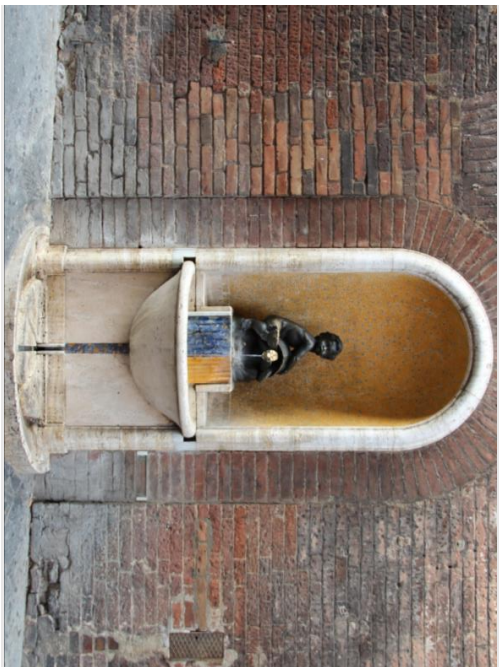
Opt. 2) Historical Top Winery Visit With Wine Pairing Lunch In A Tuscanian Farm

The family of the farm traces its roots back to the middle ages when, among other things, it had a hand in governing the city-state of Siena.

Here, the historical ageing cellars can be visited on a tour among the over 300 big barrels and thousands of bottles of Brunello di Montalcino, in order to understand the various phases in the vinification process, the techniques and secrets of ageing wine as well as the history of Brunello.

Standing Lunch in this typical farm: outside or in front of the big fireplace at the heart of the dining room, dishes in the Tuscan and, specifically, Montalcino tradition can be tasted just as they were prepared long ago and even with a slightly modern touch.





Day 2

Siena Contrada Evening Tour

Let's discover, in an exiting walking tour, the life of the Contrade, the true tradition of the Palio, the shades of a brick-built city that has given name to a colour (Sienese earth), through the stories of an authentic guide of Siena.

Siena is divided into 17 contrade, or neighbourhoods, each one boasting its own unique sense of pride, which is on full display during the Palio, a horse race that takes place every July and August. To learn more about each contrada, head to their personal museums, where the history of each is highlighted.

Early Dinner In A Senese Hostaria

The Hostaria was born from the deep love towards wine and food.

The restaurant opened in 1977, in a small narrow medieval street that from the main piazza leads up to the Pope's Lodge, very close to the fabulous Piazza del Campo in Siena, an UNESCO world heritage site.

Today the Hostaria offers a cozy environment with a light nostalgic taste.

The owner wanted to keep the ancient elegance, combining his innovative concept of fine foods tied to quality, taste and sustainability.

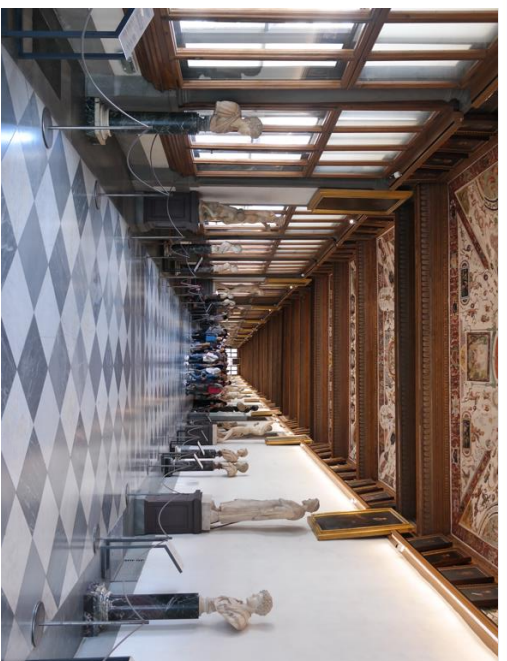
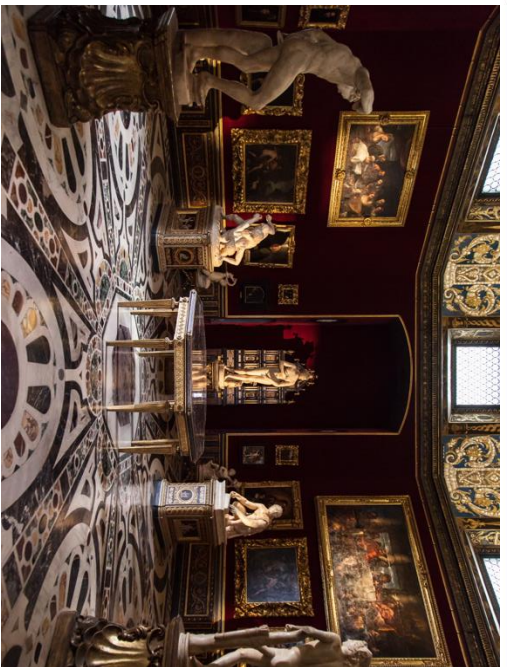
Truffle Hunt & Lunch Before Moving To Florence

Looking at the most famous artworks of the period, you will be able to understand why Florence was the birthplace of the Renaissance.





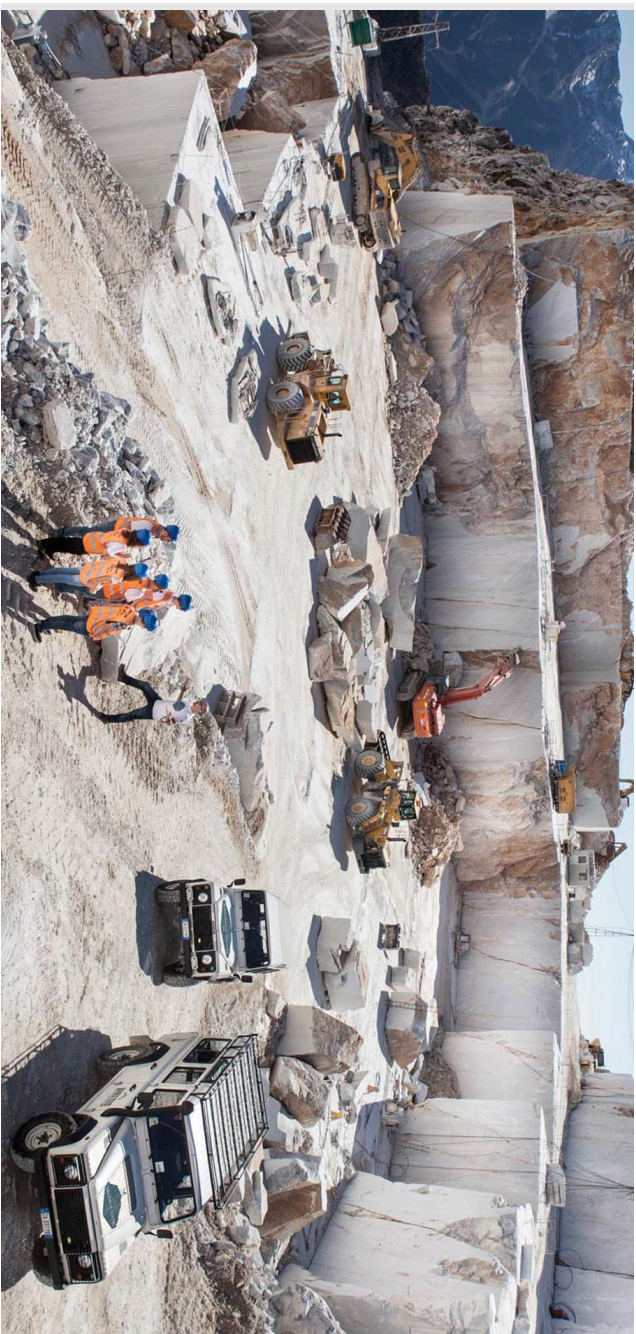
Day 3

Dinner Overlooking Arno River

Carrara Marble Tour & Colonnata Lardo Tasting (ICP product)

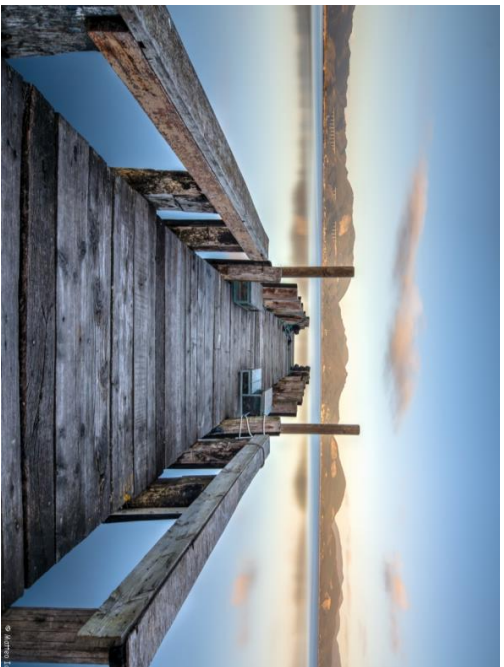
Participants will reach by coach the bacino di Colonnata and they will be divided in two smaller groups. One will remain with the guide who will explain the Marble Origin and Mine works, while the other group will enjoy a Jeep tour upper onto the caved white mountain.

An exciting off road 4x4 trip in the stunning scenery of the Carrara marble basins, where some scenes of the James Bond *Quantum of Solace* movie were filmed in 2008. With professional drivers and tour guides, guests will experience the thrill of travelling along winding, steep roads (usually inaccessible to most visitors).

Groups will swap

Transfer by coach to Colonnata, a small town of marble quarrymen whose origins date back to the beginning of the millennium and considered the capital of Lardo, for a tasting.

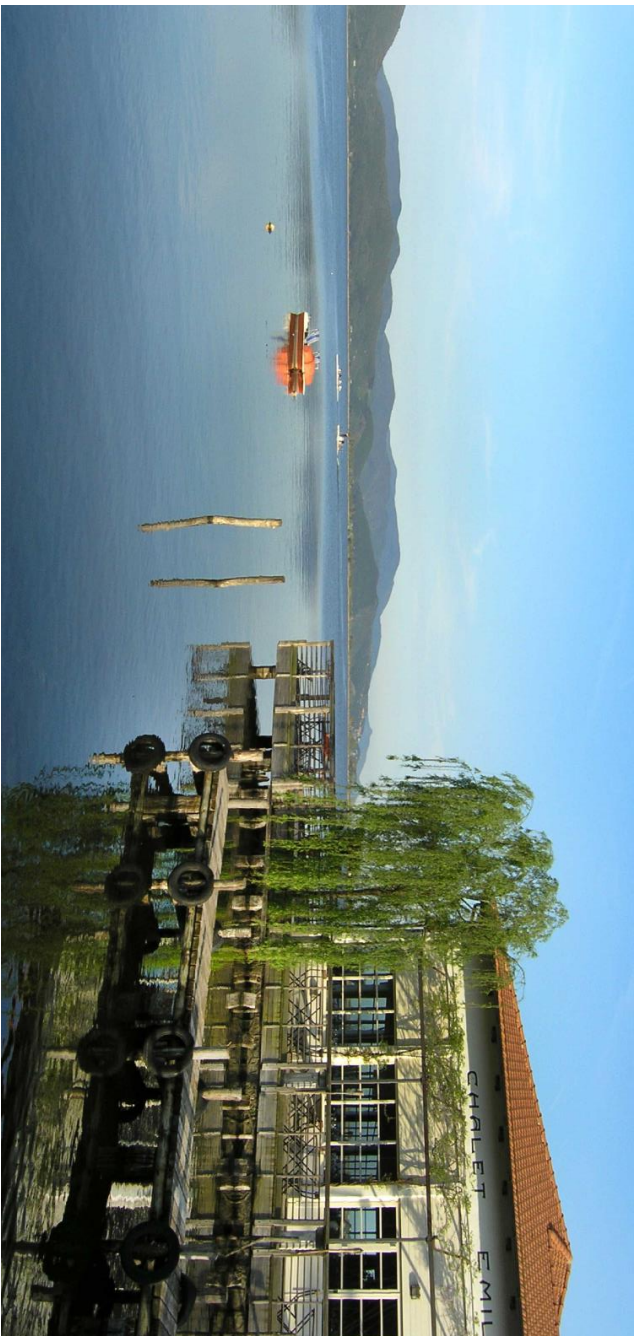
Lunch on Puccini lake

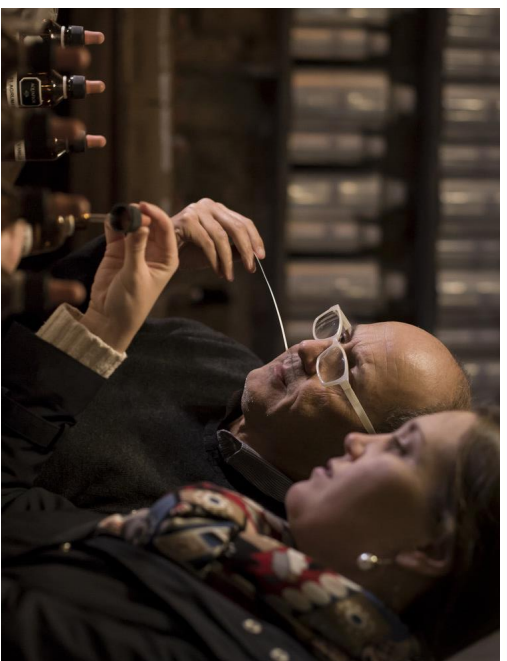
Situated on the edge of the lake of Massaciucoli the "Chalet", one can admire from the spectacular terrace the typical landscape and the impressive profile of the Apuan Alps.

Built in the end of the 19th century, this structure was marvellously renovated keeping the original shape. The "maestro" found inspiration here and visited it so frequently, that it became an important part of the memories of Puccini.

In front of the villa of Puccini and nearby the theatre, where every year the "Festival di Puccini" is held, this structure is as always the meeting-point for musicians and artists. Inside one can admire several "fresco's" from the "macchiaioli".

For its large surface and for its particular position, the structure is excellent for ceremonies and conventions. The restaurant remains open every day of the week in the months of June until August and is closed on Tuesday and Wednesday during the remaining months





Day 5

A La Carte Activities : Perfume Workshop

An interactive lesson with the olfactory specialist, you will learn the secrets and techniques of artistic perfumery. Given the unique opportunity to discover and explore exclusive essences in an intimate setting, you will then be able to apply the techniques, hands-on, creating your own personal Eau de Parfum during the session.

At the end of the workshop, you will receive a bottle of the perfume made with your own unique formula, accompanied by notes on the lesson, details, and perfumery references for further exploration.

Day 5

A La Carte Activities : Leather Workshop

Participants will be monitored and guided by the master craftsman for the entire duration of the workshop.

Starting with a brief introduction on the history of leather in Tuscany and leather processing activities, continuing with the exploration of the the materials that will be used during the workshop.

Customization of the belt with the initials stamped using hot gold.

Continuing with the selection of leather belt models which have been previously cut, each participant can paint his own leather belt with a particular technique or leave it natural color. After this processing, the participants will devote themselves to sew the part of the buckle choice once over the belt.

Day 5

A La Carte Activities : Fresco Making

Learn the the art of true fresco with an art historian/professional fresco painter in his studio in the artisan's section of Florence. Beginning with a brief but informative explanation of the art of 'buon fresco' including the chemical nature of the ancient technique, mixing of colors and methods of painting, students will then make a small copy in fresco of a detail of one of the frescoes in Florence. Each participant will make their own preparatory cartoon used to paint the fresco, mix their own natural pigments for painting and execute the fresco using the same materials and methods as the great fresco painters of the Renaissance like Giotto, Masaccio and Michelangelo. All will walk away with a fresco copy of their own making (small enough to put in a carry-on) , preparatory cartoon and small informational fresco packet with terms and diagrams.

A La Carte Activities : Cooking Class in a special location

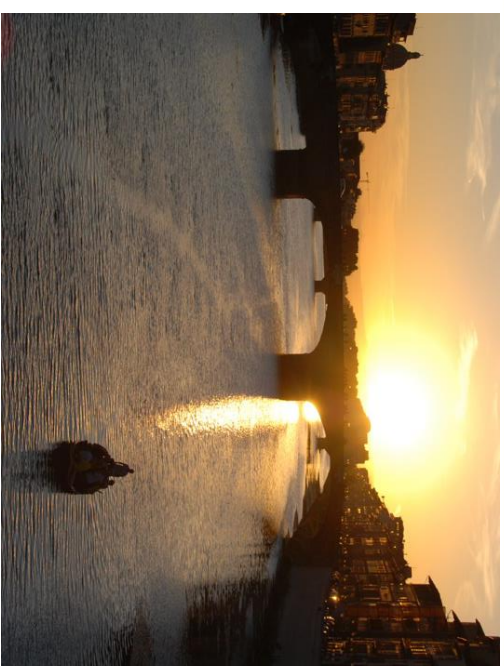
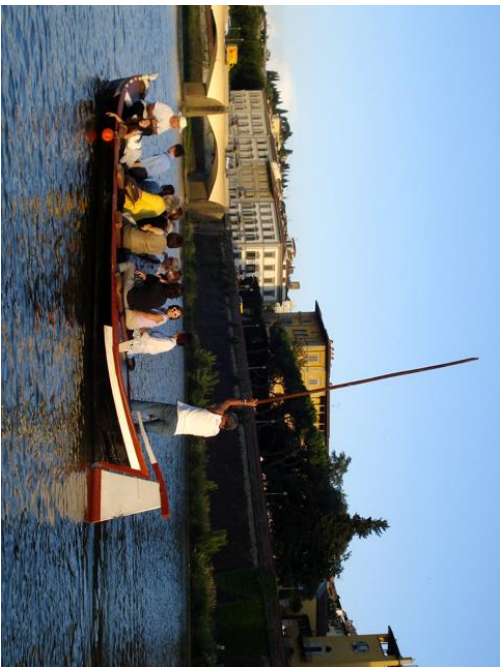

Arno has always been a huge part of Florentine history; Arno defines the Florentine landscape as well.

The Arno river cruise project is organised by a relatively young association, but it roots in the story of the city. In 1995 the “Associazione Culturale i Renaioli” was established.

The mission of this cultural association is to recover, conserve and preserve the historical Arno boats and their use.

The Arno River Cruise – barchetto experience – is on between May and September. The barchetti leave from Lungarno Diaz, the experience takes around 1 hour (45 minutes of navigation, around 15 minutes for embarkation and disembarkation procedures).

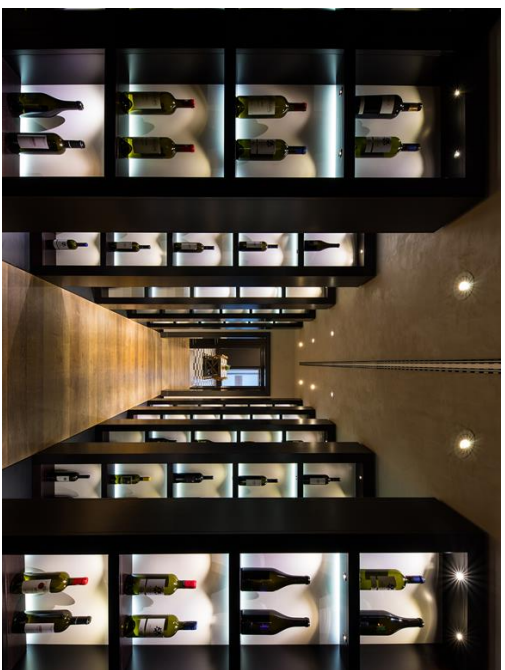
Day 5

Or maybe it's better to say that it is here that still lives: where now stands this restaurant, in fact, since the early nineteenth century there was a small inn.





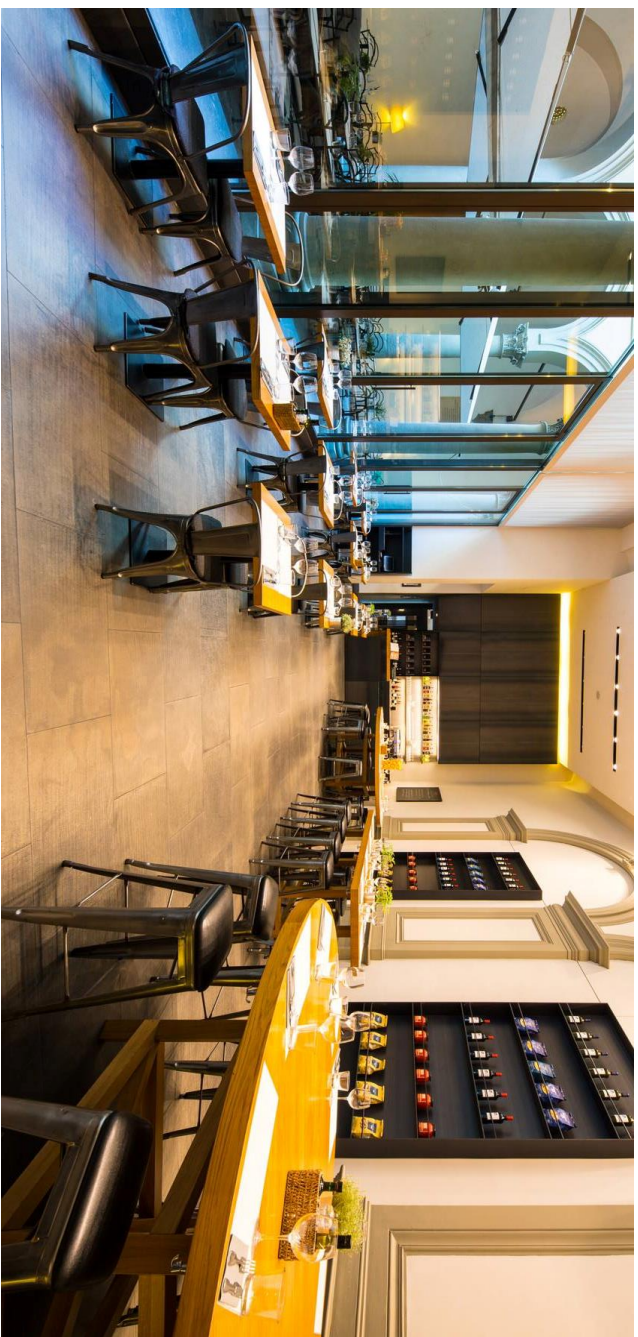
Day 3

Day 5 - Option 1

Gala Dinner In A Historical Palace

Work on this Palace began in 1489, to the design of Giuliano da Sangallo, and inaugurated in June of 1495 by the Duke of Urbino, during a visit to Florence.

In 1600, the beautiful fountain in the courtyard was added. In the 18th and early 19th century, various restoration and embellishment projects were implemented to adapt some of the rooms to the taste of the time.

In the 1870s the City of Florence decided to widen the street that passed before this Palace, and the architect Poggi was chosen to direct the work. Poggi demolished an old palace, which was contiguous with the one designed by Sangallo, and widened the building, completing the facade overlooking Via dei Condi as well.





Day 5 – Option 2

Gala dinner In A Palace Overlooking The Arno River

The spectacular Sala Poccetti can be found in the magnificent 16th century Palace right next to Ponte Santa Trinita in Florence, just a short walk from our charming hotels.

This space of extraordinary beauty, with sumptuous frescoes adorning the walls, and the latest technology, provides a magical stage for meetings, congresses, prestigious events, receptions, and gala evenings in Florence.





Day 5 - Option 3

Gala Dinner In A Downton Palace

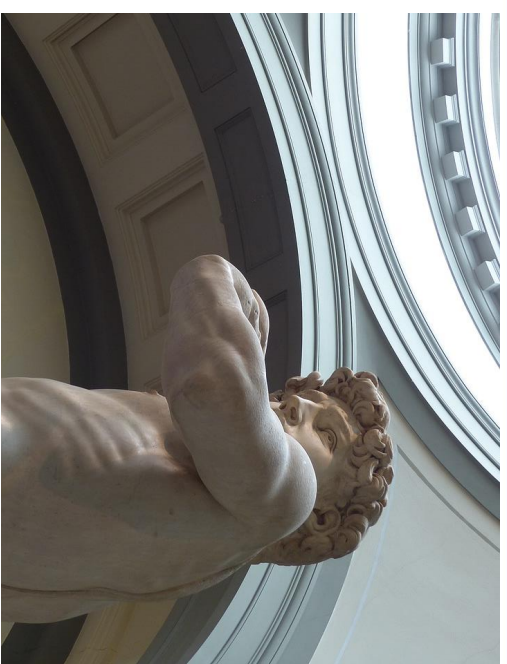
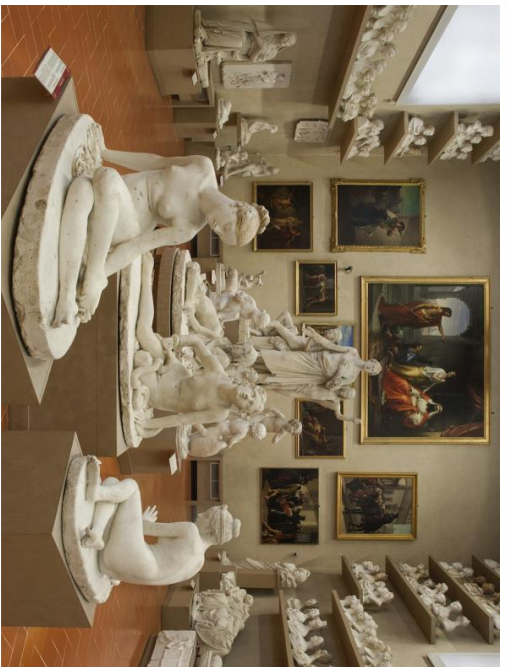
A La Carte Activities : Visit To The Dome Of Florence & Opera Museum

With this tour, guests will have the chance to discover the true history behind this marvelous and astonishing city of Florence!

The Cathedral stands tall over the city with its magnificent Renaissance dome designed by Filippo Brunelleschi. The Cathedral, named in honor of Santa Maria del Fiore, is a vast Gothic structure built on the site of the 7th century church of Santa Reparata.

The Opera museum, on the other hand, collects works of art from the sacred complex of the Duomo of Florence, Baptistery and Giotto's Bell Tower, with a very important core of Gothic and Renaissance statuary.



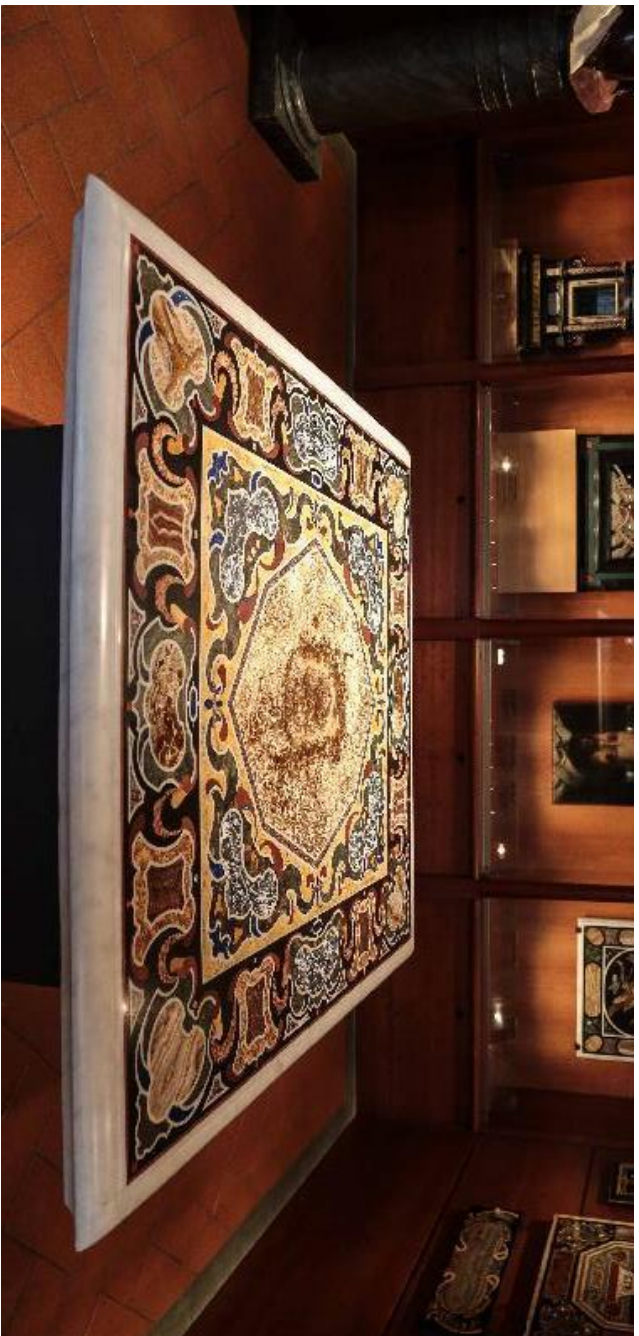
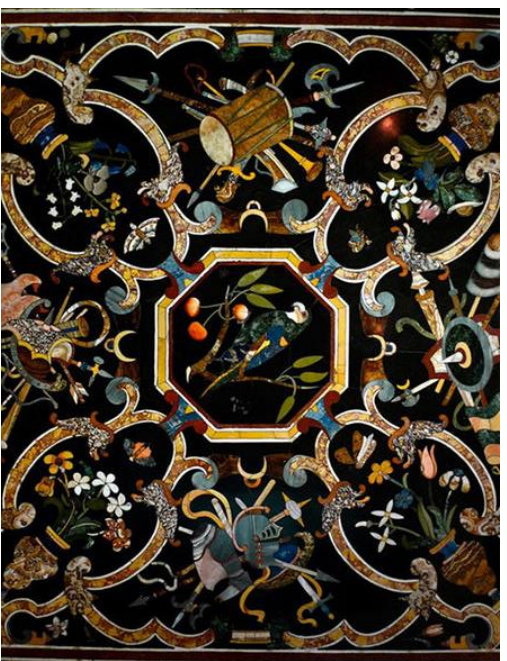

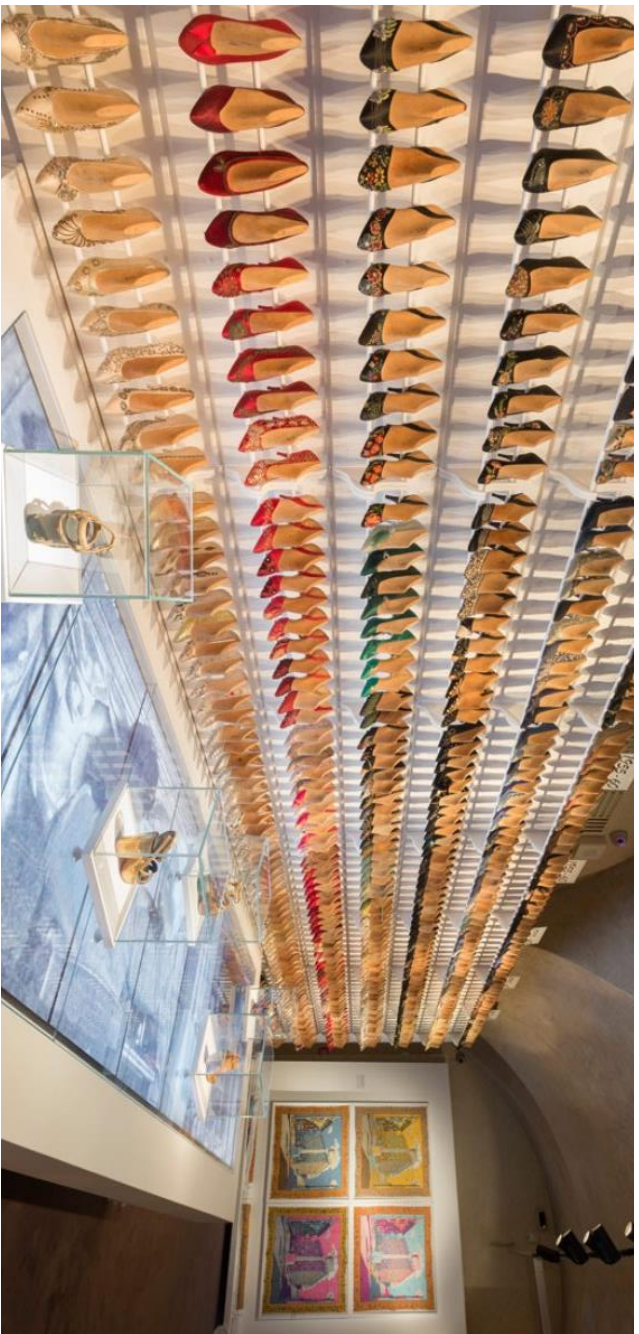
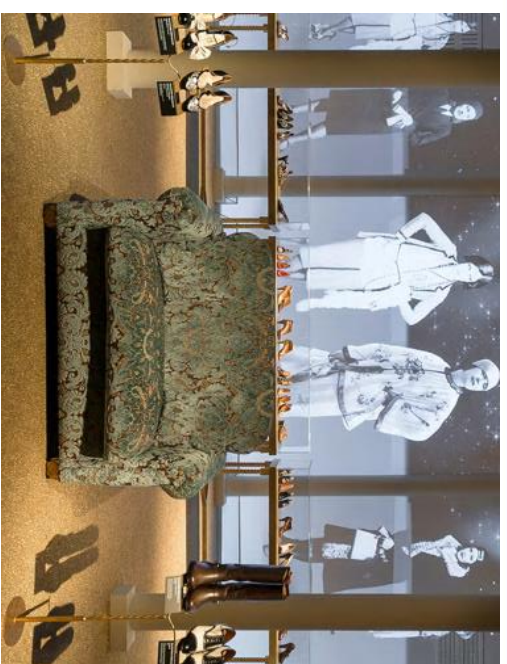
Day 6

A La Carte Activities : Special Visit To The Opificio Delle Pietre Dure

Descendant in direct line from the artistic laboratory founded by the Medici in 1588, this sector has cultivated and handed down to the present day the sophisticated dexterity, which allows to restore the mosaics of precious stones (also known as "salesmen") to a level of specialization, which only the Opificio holds today. For the restoration of highly decorative applied art objects, such as the stone clerks, it is in fact necessary to master the executive technique, to be able, where the conservative situation of the work permits, to return them Meaning and image integrity.

Through this visit, the guests will have the possibility to discover the ancient art of the restoration of precious stones, along with some pieces of art!





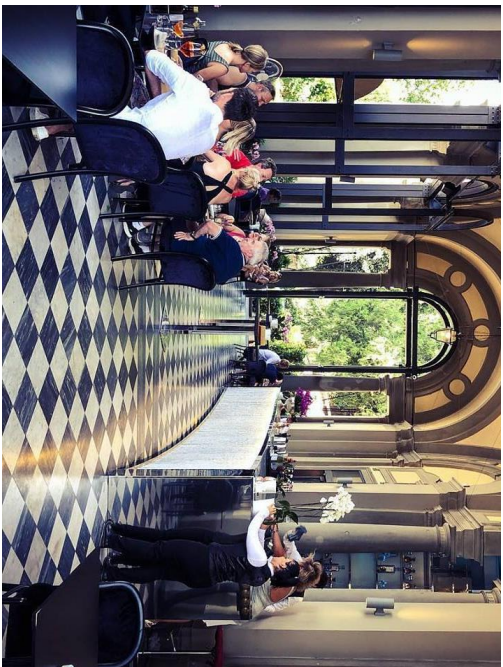
Day 6

A La Carte Activities : Visit At Ferragamo Museum Welcomed By The Museum Manager

The museum's footwear collection documents the entire span of Salvatore Ferragamo's career, from his return to Italy in 1927 to 1960 the year he died. It highlights his technical and artistic skills which, through his color choices, the creativity of the designs and use of innovative materials made a fundamental contribution to the growth and establishment of Made in Italy. Some of the items reveal Salvatore Ferragamo's relationships with artists of his day, such as the futurist painter, Lucio Venna who created some advertising sketches and the famous Ferragamo footwear label.

There are the shoes that are famous because they were made for Hollywood stars such as Marilyn Monroe, Greta Garbo and Audrey Hepburn. A century of history told by footwear.





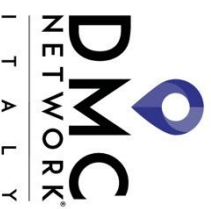
