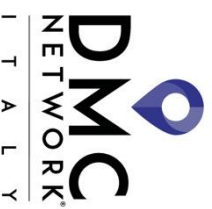
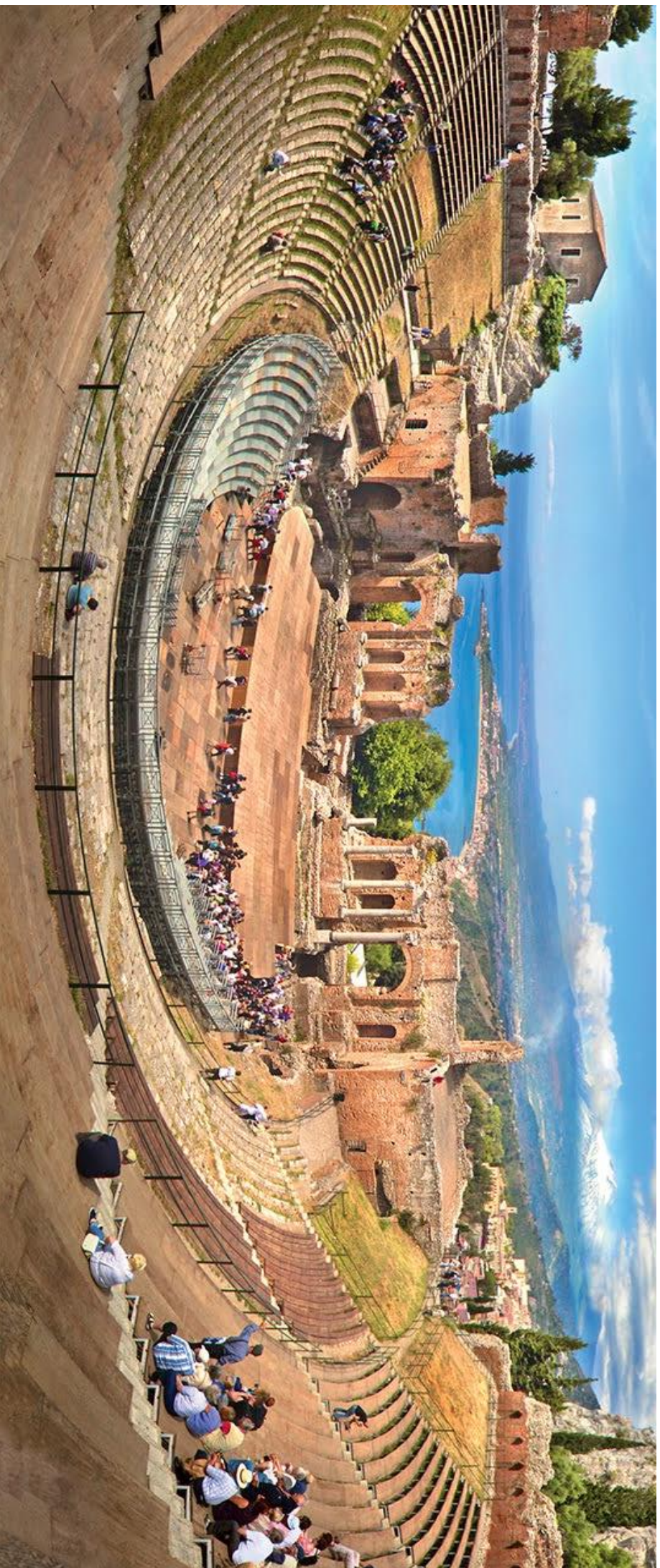

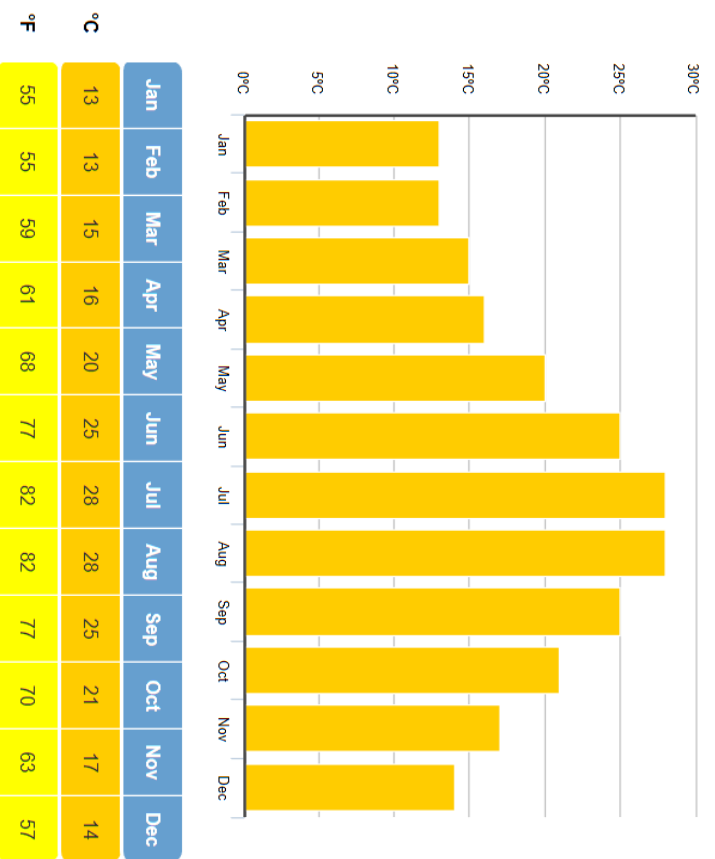
Catania Airport

Approx. 1h (65,6 Km) transfer from Catania airport to Taormina city centre

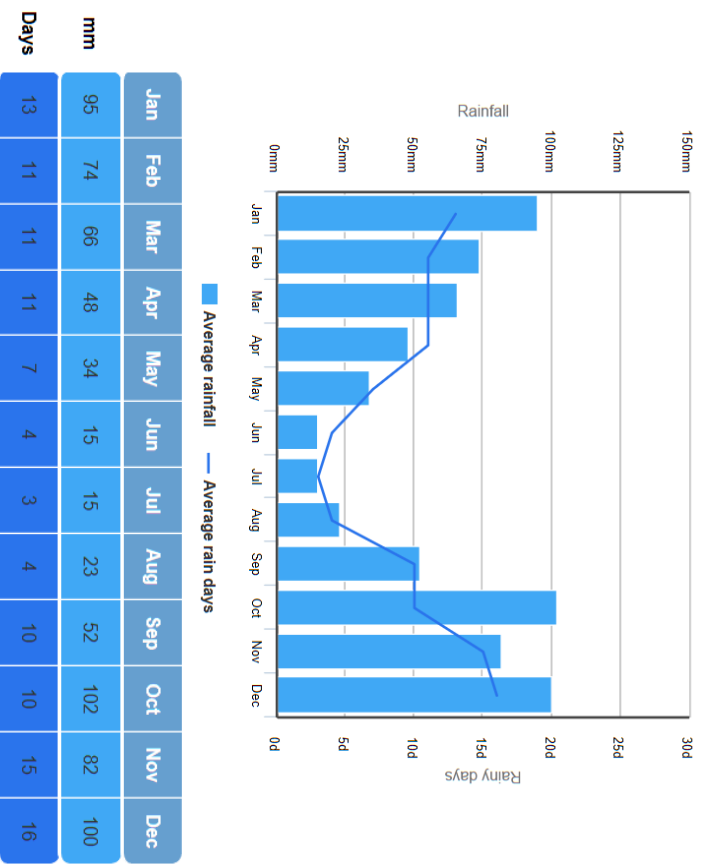


Taormina Climate

Day 1

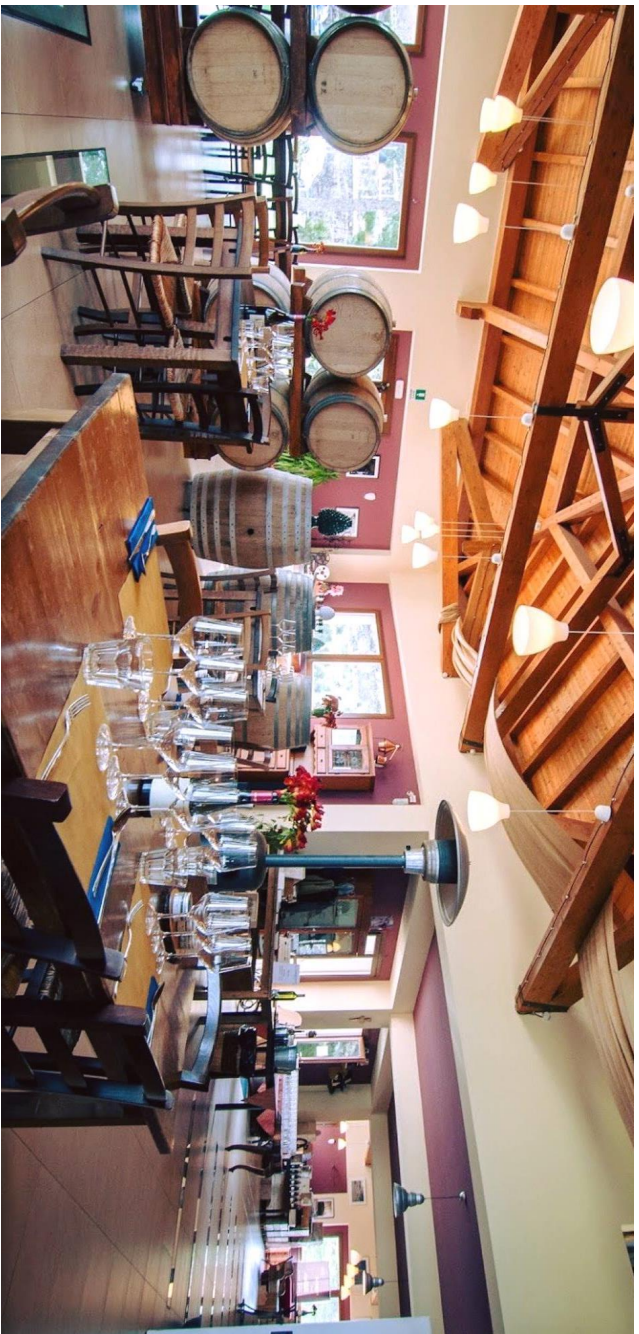
Etna Discovery by Jeep

After the jeep tour on the Etna volcano, there will be a stop for a lunch at the winery "Gambino", where you can taste some of the best sicilian recipes & visit the estate!





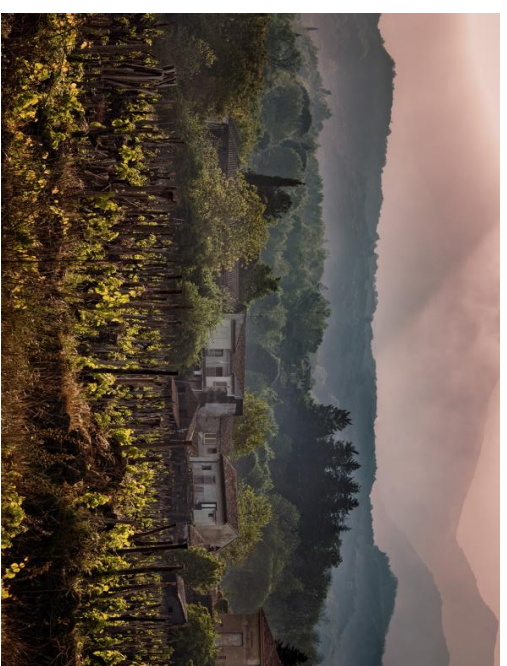
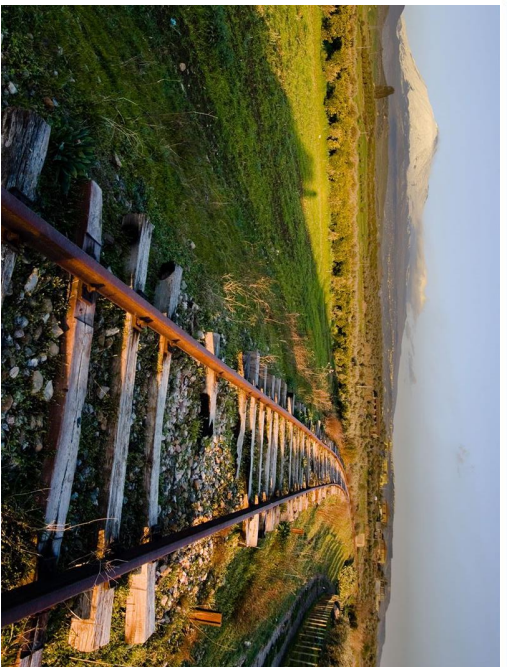
Day 2

Tasting Lunch In A National Park Winery

For this winery, wine is a journey you get ready for everyday, which never ends. It is a discovery of new colors and tastes different every vintage, which make the experience of working in the vineyards and winery full of unique sensations and values, from the land that grows the grapes to the people that look for it.

The group will have an unforgettable experience entering the wine world among high altitude vineyards and local genuine tastes. Enveloped in such a suggestive and unique context we offer wine tastings served by qualified sommeliers accompanied by typical local specialties.





Day 2

In the afternoon, divided in two group activities:

1) Etna tour By Train

An original and alternative way to discover the volcano Etna 1st surely a round with the ferrovia Circumetnea (FCE) train. It's an historic train line opened in the year 1898. The Circumetnea is 110 Km long and runs around the Etna, crossing a lot of little villages at the feet of the volcano and delivering suggestive views of the typical dark lava landscape of the area. The Circumetnea route goes from the station Catania Borgo to Riposto. Trains run in both directions and cross Etna villages like Paternò, Adrano, Bronte and Randazzo. The Circumetnea is not a pure touristic train, although touristic runs with ancient wagons are sometimes organized. It's rather a train for commuter workers.





Day 2

In the afternoon, divided in two group activities:

2) Quad

The departure of the activity can be carried out on Etna, Nebrodi and Valle of Alcantara.

The route develops along mixed and varied roads dislevels, between asphalt, fiumare, dirt roads with woods of chestnut trees and lava flows.

Day 2

Dinner In A Sicilian Farmhouse

This former fortified farmhouse is set in a green orchard, in Taormina's flat estate. Surrounded by beautiful green citrus grove, that belonged to the family from which the district retains the name.

The structure incorporates the features of the architecture of Taormina and is able to convey the charm of reviving old-world atmosphere. The structure has maintained in its thorough restructuring the typical architectural characteristics of these buildings: a high floor, reserved for the owner, a ground floor, used to work for the transformation of agricultural products such as the millstone for the wine, the olive press for the oil, the bread oven, stables, warehouses and location destined to the servants and peasants.





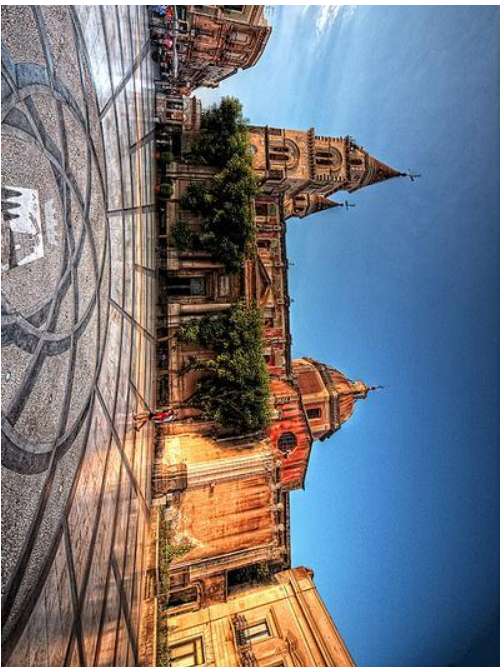
Day 3

Opt. 1 – Luxury coach Tour Siracusa, Ortigia & Ragusa

Departure from the hotel at 8.30 a.m. to Ragusa. Ragusa is divided in two, Ragusa Superiore and Ragusa Inferiore, known also as "Ibla", (originally Híbla Heráia). It is in Ragusa Inferiore that the most important monuments can be found, buildings such as the Church of St Maria delle Scale, the Cathedral of St Giovanni Battista, the Church of Purgatory with its Baroque portal, and Palazzo Donnafugata in which there are splendid paintings assigned to Antonello da Messina. Delicious lunch with beverage included in a gourmet restaurant in Ragusa. After that the group will reach Syracuse to visit the archaeological site (Dionysius Ear, Greek Theatre, Latomie) and the historical centre of Ortigia island (Arethusa's fountain and the Cathedral).
Coffee break with typical products in renews local bar and transfer back to Taormina.

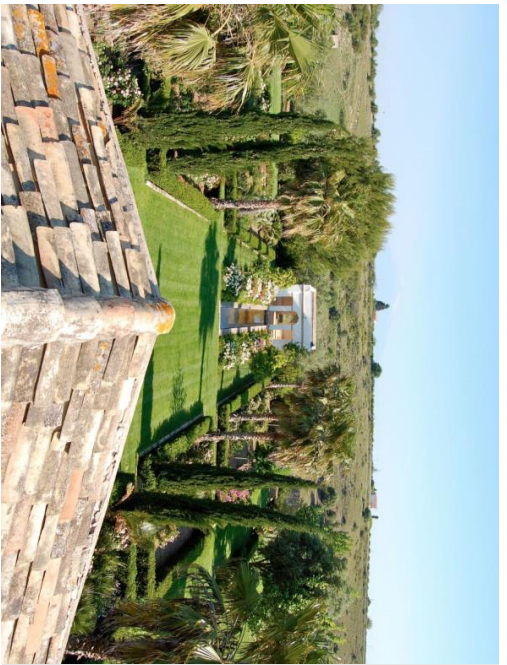
Opt. 2 – Vintage Car Rally to Ortigia

Its rooms have been restored from the remains of a religious building collapsed in the earthquake of 1693. The beautiful Catalan vaults create special atmosphere.





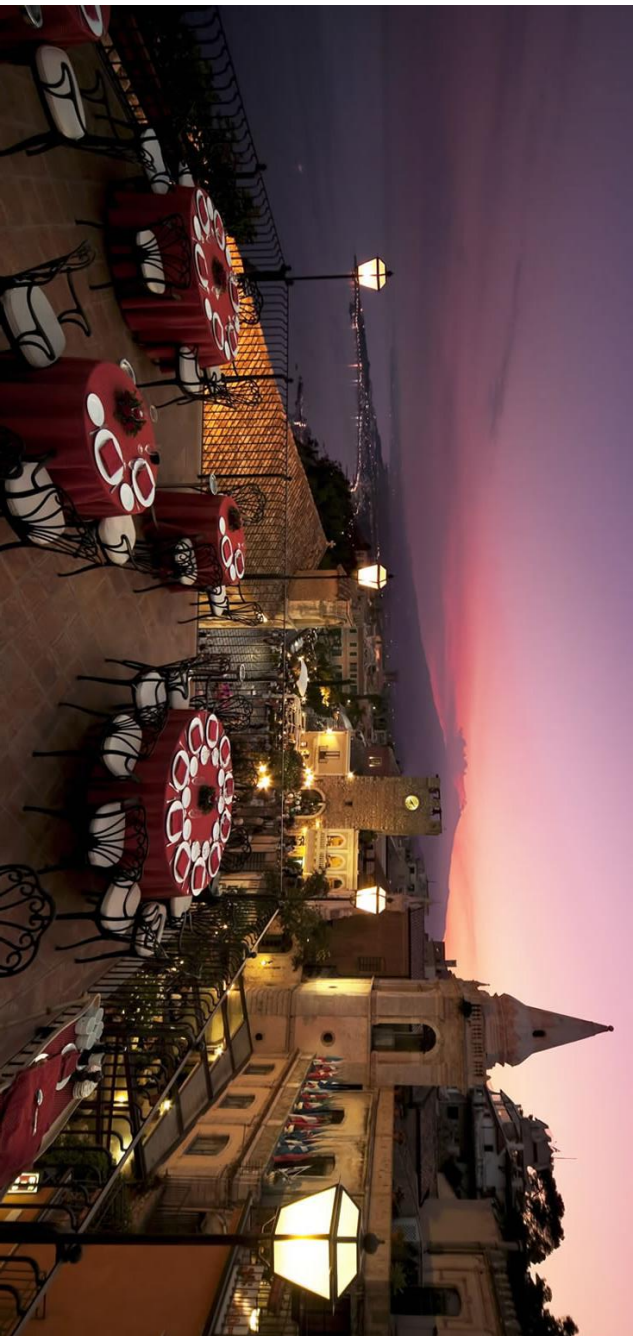

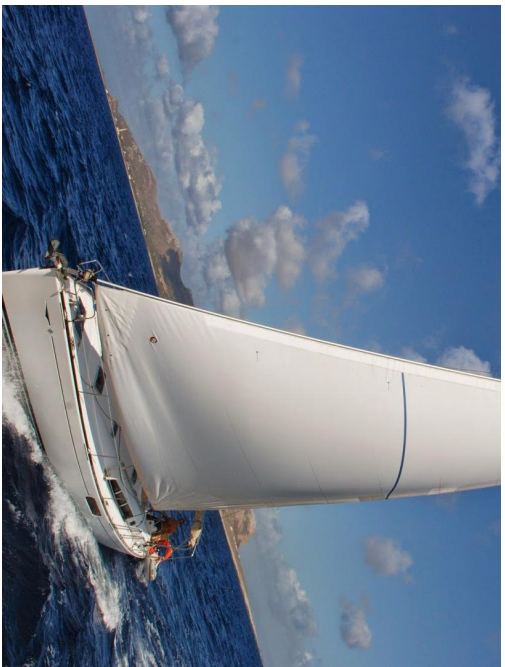
Dinner In A Restaurant Overlooking The Sicilian Sea

Day 4

Sailing Regatta Challenge

The regatta is organized with sail boats over a course which will be set out and marked by the organization, the course will be decided based on the weather conditions (prevailing wind & wind speed). Before the race, a briefing will take place in the hotel to explain the course and the rules - including safety advice. The participants will be divided into teams and assigned a sail boat and skipper (maximum capacity of each boat: 7/9 person + skipper). The race judge (who will have been aboard the support dingy), will inform the group leader which boat completed the race in the shortest time incurring the fewest penalties. At all times the guests will be under the supervision of expert sailors, and a dingy (with outboard motor) will closely follow the race, ready to support or assist if needed





Day 4

Dinner opt. 1: In A Typical Villa w/ Classical Music Group

This villa is located directly on the Gulf of Isola Bella. The chefs have been able to represent the authentic modern Mediterranean cuisine: great products, local dishes revised with higher sensitivity and technique, and culture of the service, no indulgence to the ephemeral fashions of taste and catering.

Dinner opt. 2: In A Stylish Restaurant w/ Disco

The terrace offers a panoramic view that extends from Etna to the enchanting bay of the ancient Naxos until the tip of Augusta.

The elegant restaurant at the heart of the historic "Clara" is illuminated by four lamps that draw attention to the guest for an elegant and original design.



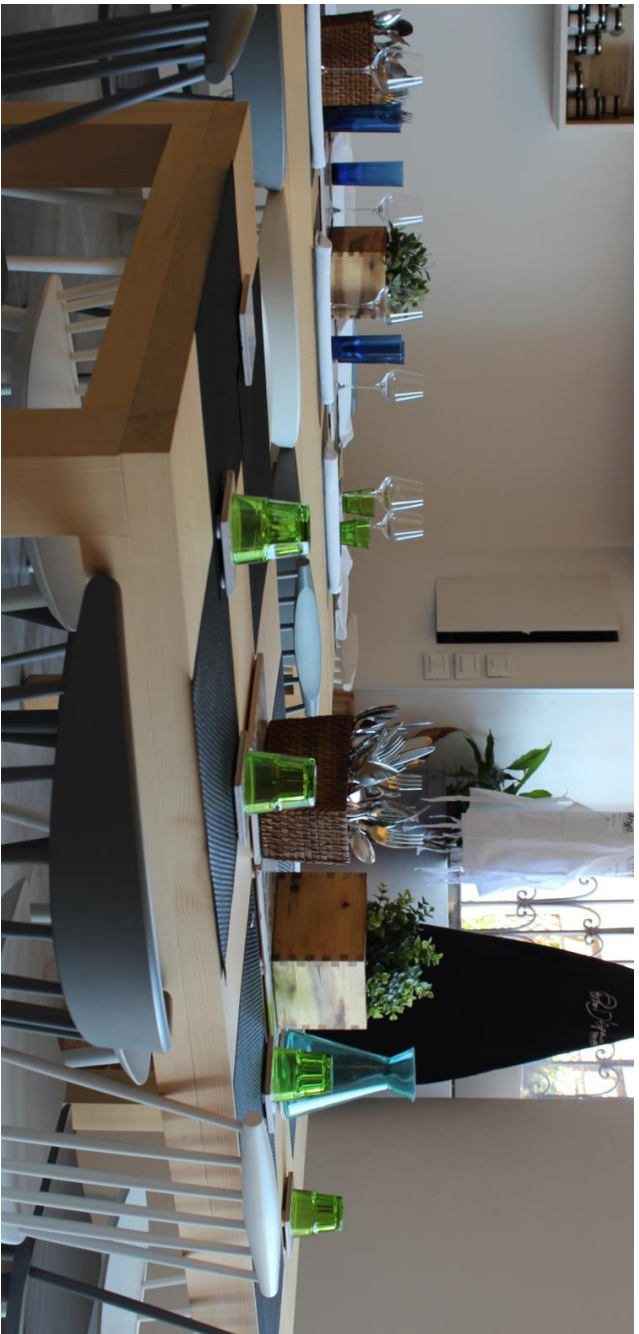


Day 5

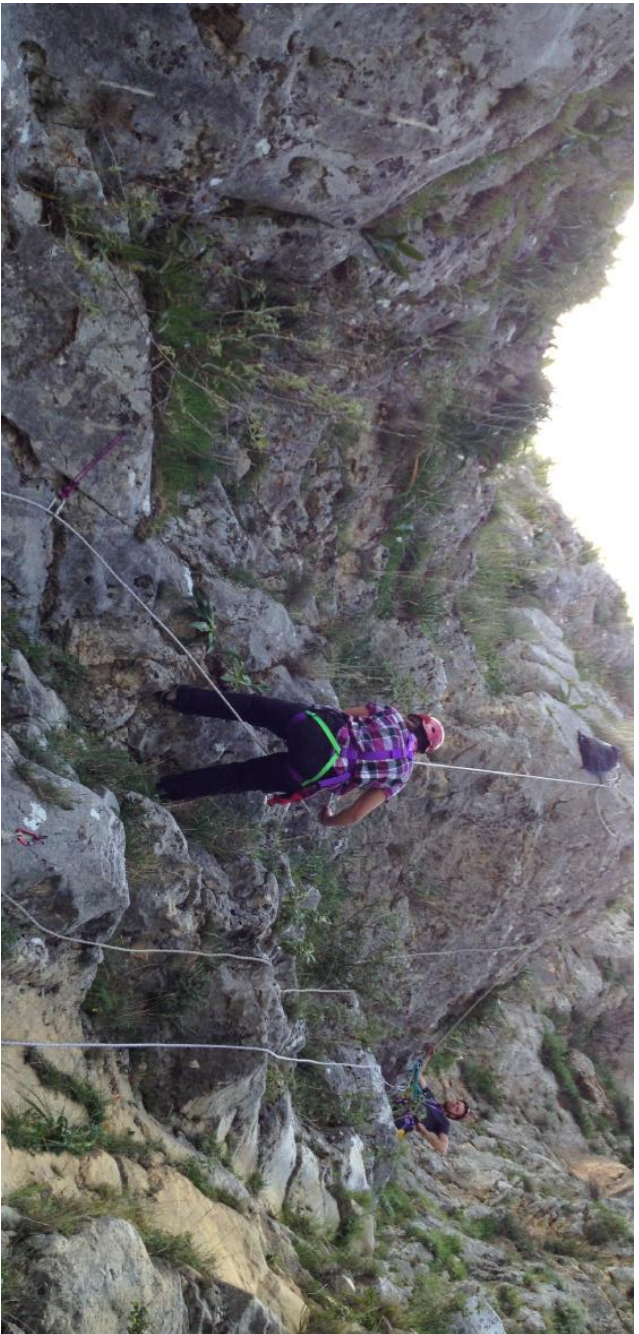
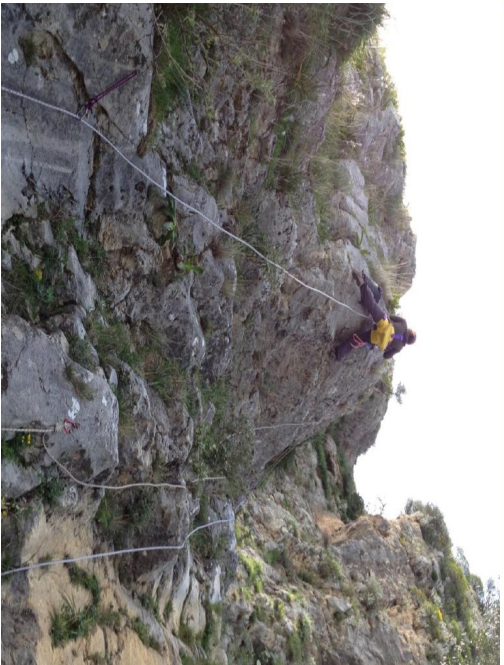
A La Carte Activity #2: Bike Tour From Giardini DI Naxos To Torre Archirafi

Depart from the port of Naxos and travel along the first stretch in off road crossing the river mouth Alcantara, this stretch will take you directly to the magnificent seafont marina Cottone that has been for the last 20 years, the cleanest sea in Italy. You will enjoy the village of Riposto with its Cathedral and ancient port, continuing on the bike and normal road, we will arrive to the ancient fish market placed exactly opposite the port of Etna.

The end of the itinerary will be in the magnificent bay of Archirafi's tower and you will return on the same way back to the base.

Day 5

A La Carte Activity #3: Climbing

The activity is carried out along the rocky walls that are between the countries of Taormina, Castelmola and Moio Alcantara. The group is met on the spot and divided into teams, during the briefing are delivered and explained the Equipment and climbing technique on the cliff. The ways to climb are mixed and various difficulties from 10MT to 35MT. At the beginning of the paths the participants are Sated and secured with a rope to the top of the wall. All Safety manoeuvres are carried out by specialised guides.





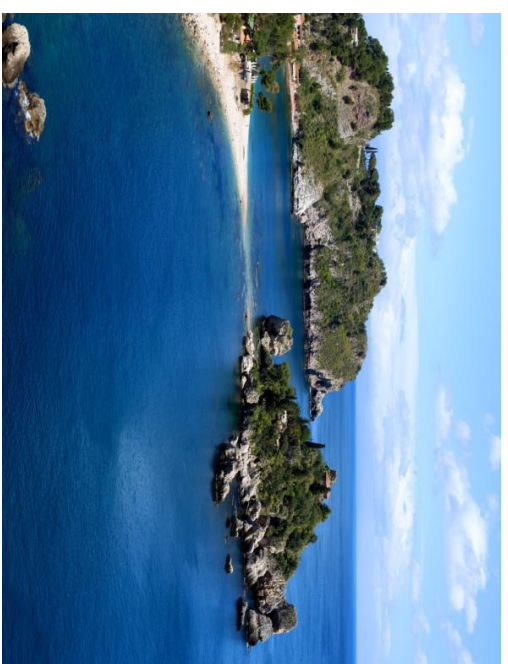
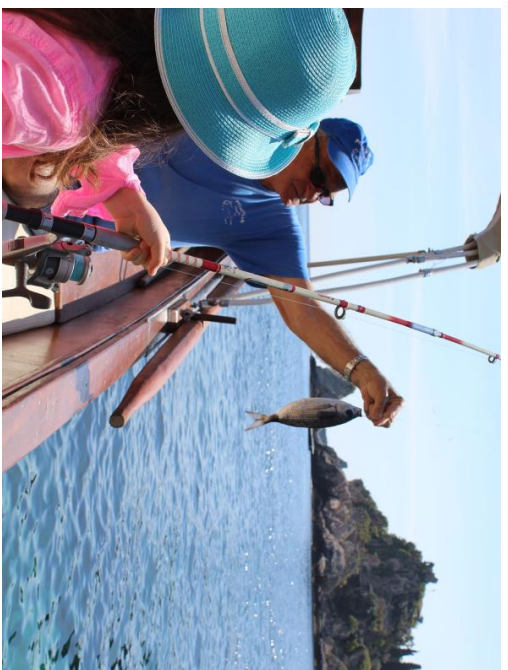
Day 5

A La Carte Activity #4: Body Rafting

The Gole Alcantara Botanical and Geological Park is the ideal location for body rafting. This sensational body river descent allows rafters to visit a part of the canyon as well as the section most downstream, drawn through the water rapids. The return is upstream amidst waterfalls and lava boulders. The body rafting departure is at the Spiaggetta delle Gole [Gorges beach], winding through the river canyon downstream (Vulcano route), reaching small gorges, waterfalls and creeks that are often invisible and unreachable.

Duration: 2h 30 min





Day 5

A La Carte Activity #5: Fishing Experience

Departure from the hotel at 9.00 am towards the coast of Taormina and boarding with the typical Sicilian fisherman boats.

The group will be divided in boats of 5 max people each. Fishing tour of about 2 hours along the coast of Taormina.

The fisher Man will arrange for each guest the fishing line, bait and snacks on board (mineral water and seasonal fruit).

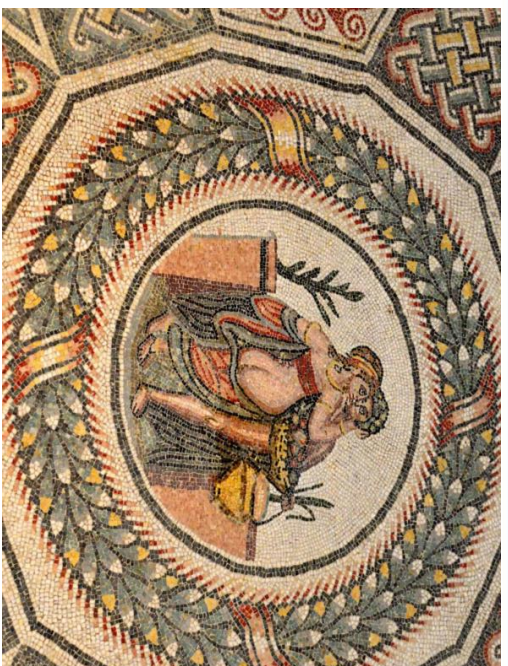
In accord with the client's wishes the boat could stop for a bath break during the fishing session.

Landing in Isola Bella natural reserve each group will weight the catch and deliver it to the chef for the cooking. Lunch with barbeque in a local restaurant located right on the beach.

After lunch opportunity to have a relax moments on the beach. (sun bed and umbrellas will be available for the group).

This excursion takes at least 6 hours it is depending upon the weather and sea conditions.



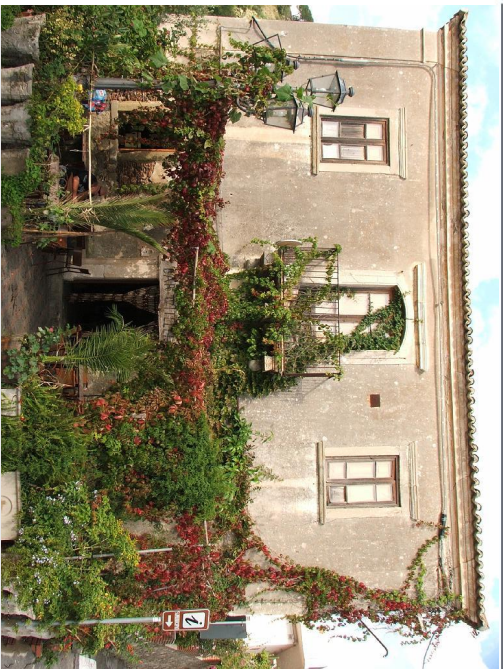


Day 5

A La Carte Activity #6: Tour of Villa Romana and Caltagirone

Discover the world's finest pottery and mosaics during the excursion to Roman Villa and Caltagirone! Piazza Armerina, almost in the center of Sicily, is a nice small town famous in the world for the Archaeological Park which includes the "Villa Romana del Casale". The Roman Villa (from the 4th century) includes many magnificent mosaics and representations of classical mythology, in excellent condition. Have a great lunch (not included) at a typical restaurant in Caltagirone, a nice town famous for the production of pottery. Seat at the wonderful staircase of S. Maria del Monte, which leads to the Cathedral. All of the 142 steps are made of lava and decorated with exquisite floral and geometric motifs. Have a refreshment tasting the local sweets made of fresh "ricotta".

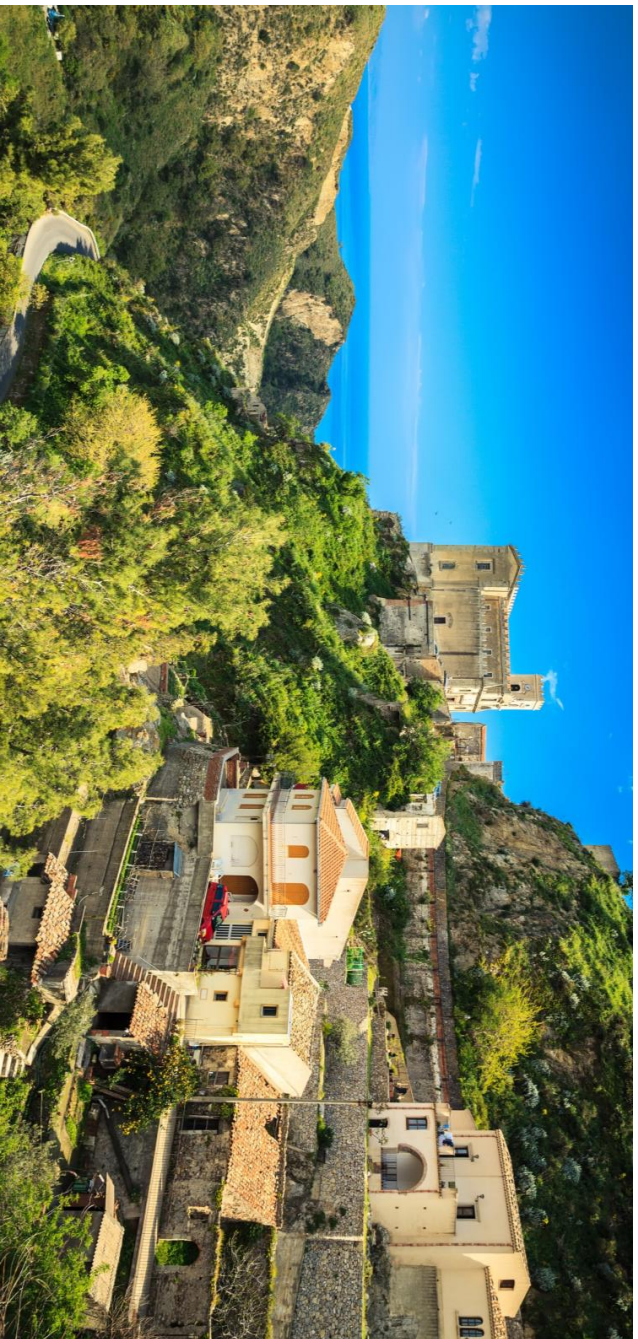
A La Carte Activity #7: The Godfather Locations Tour

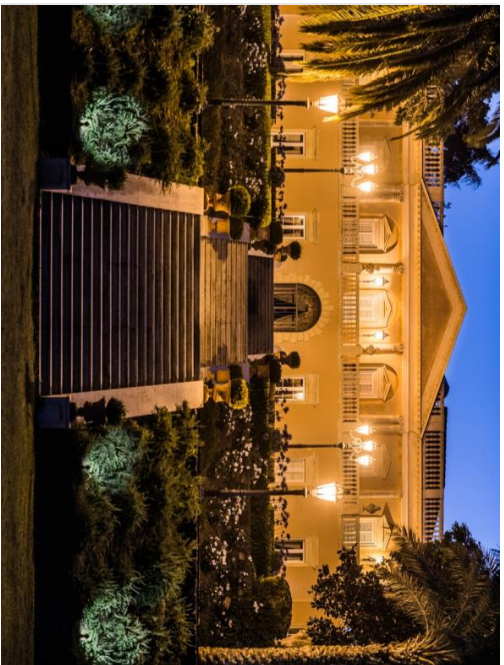
Discover The Godfather filming locations: visit “The Castle of Slaves” in Fiumefreddo, a baroque building from the 18th century (many scenes of The Godfather trilogy by Francis Ford Coppola were shot there).

Enjoy the panoramic road to Forza d’Agro. In this small town you will enjoy a stunning view of the East coast of Sicily.

At lunchtime reach Savoca and enjoy a special Sicilian lunch at a refined restaurant. In the afternoon visit the old bar Vitelli, where The Godfather was filmed. It was featured in the motion picture as the place where Michael Corleone asked Apollonia’s father to meet his daughter.

Take a picture at the church of San Nicolò, where The Godfather’s wedding takes place.

Gala Dinner In A Luxurious Villa

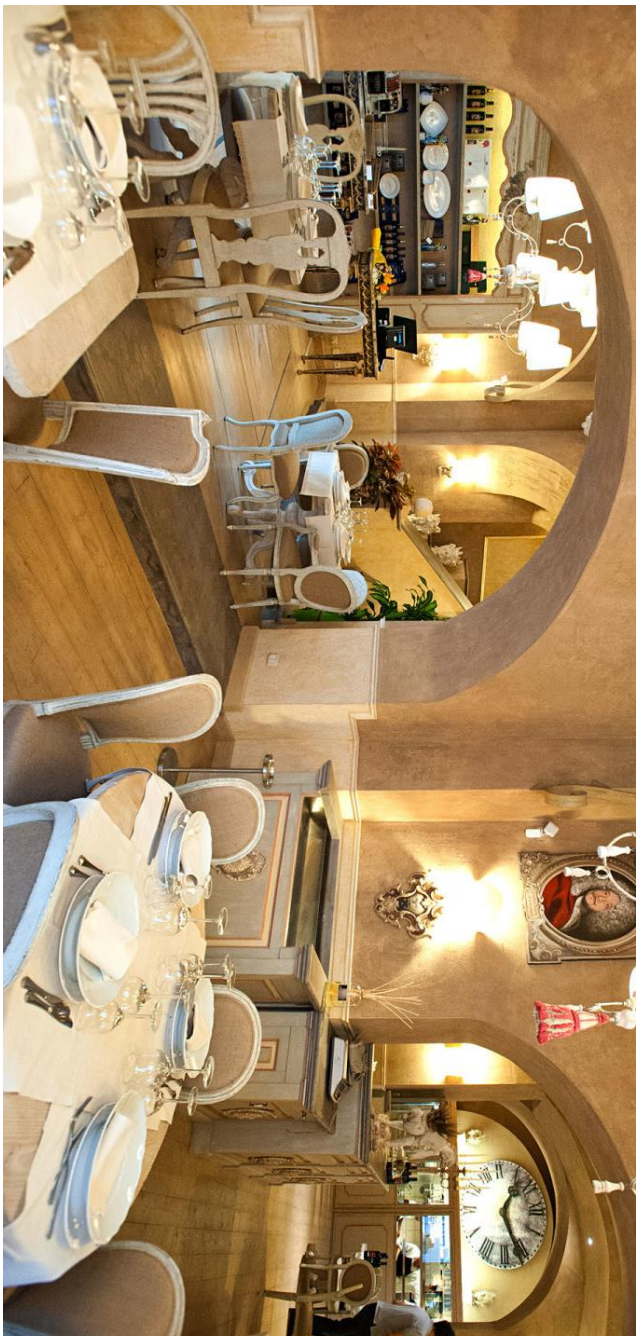


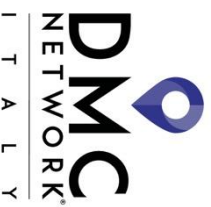
Day 6
